

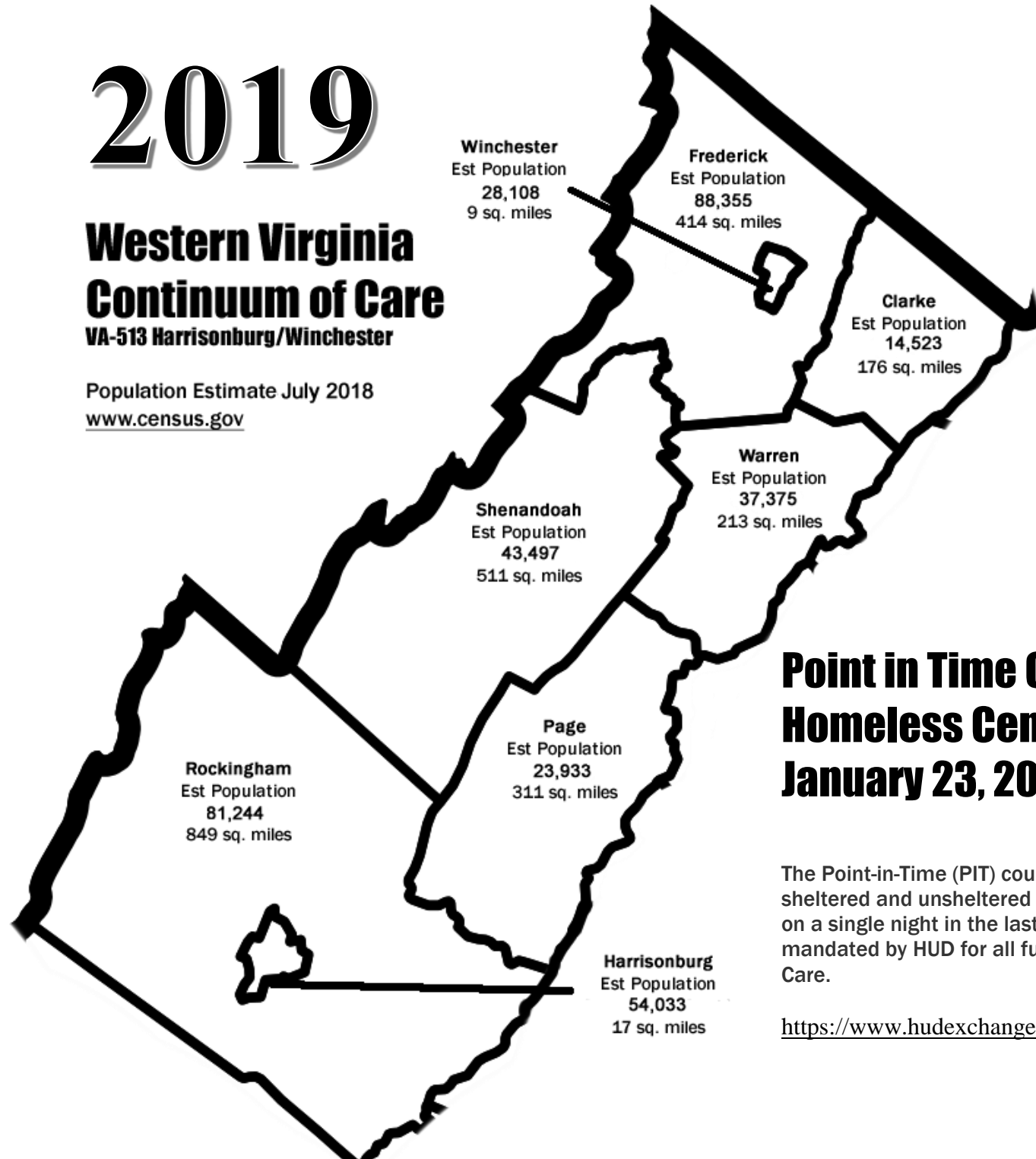

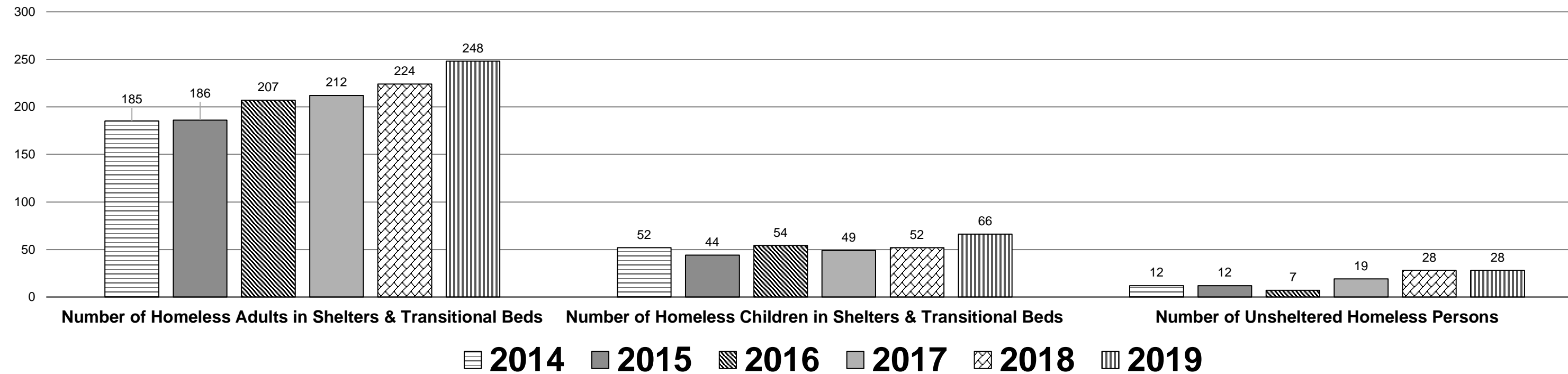
Point in Time Count Homeless Census January 23, 2019

The Point-in-Time (PIT) count is a count of sheltered and unsheltered homeless persons on a single night in the last 10 days of January, mandated by HUD for all funded Continuums of Care.

Point in Time Notes

Winchester:
The Laurel Center in Winchester was closed for a physical move to their new 32 bed facility on January 24th 2018. This impacted Winchester's numbers in 2018. The new 32 bed facility was open during the PiT Count in 2019.

Through coordination with Valley Assistance Network (VAN) in Winchester and area homeless assistance service providers, The Point in Time reflects 24 sheltered persons in hotels paid for by local government, churches and non-profits.

This contributed an additional 24 shelter beds to our 2019 housing inventory. Without this emergency shelter effort, the unsheltered persons in Winchester would likely be higher.

Woodstock:
One domestic services shelter did not respond to data requests. Last year's numbers were used as proxy.

Harrisonburg: Available shelter beds decreased from 184 to 144 (28 family beds, 12 single beds) due to shelter changes.
